TORRINGTON, CT - ACT, the Arts and Culture Commission of Torrington, CT is excited to announce the launch of their most recent initiative. This Thursday, December 20th at 5pm the brand new “City Hall Auditorium Gallery” will be officially open to the public.

Utilizing the back wall of the auditorium and the recently installed hanging system, ACT is proud to open this new space with works of art from three local and very special artists - Victor Leger, Janet Iffland and Marc Stolfi. Victor is a highly respected educator at Torrington High School, an award winning artist, and an inspiring voice in the regional art community. Janet is another professionally recognized artist, whose paintings in oil and acrylic reflect her love for the light and landscape of this this area. Marc is accomplished in many fine art mediums and has recently drawn on his training as an illustrator to create murals for the children’s wing of the Torrington Library.

The Torrington Arts and Culture Commission extends a warm invitation to everyone to attend the opening of The City Hall Auditorium Gallery, Thursday, December 20th from 5pm – 8pm. Refreshments will be served.

This new gallery space will be a high visibility venue in which to showcase and enjoy artwork made by local and regional artists. The Commission has plans to further enhance our landmark City Hall with the creation of more art display spaces such as a student art gallery, and a space to feature single artist shows. They also plan to add more photo murals to the three which are already installed – two panoramic enlargements printed on aluminum depicting the downtown in 1869 and 1913, and a beautiful color enlargement also printed on aluminum showcasing a very busy Main Street Marketplace.
